# RIESLING PULVERMÄCHER BERGE GG 2019

Right at the edge of the radar screen for German wine, but that's what makes it so exciting. Ripe plum and quince aromas, plus a slew of dried herbs, are married to impressive textural complexity in this fullbodied and deeply structured dry riesling. Very complex finish, in which youthful, mature, herbal and mineral elements are beautifully intertwined. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold.



### RIESLING SCHILFSANDSTEIN 2019

I love the deep nose of lemon-curd, candied-lemon and floral notes, but it barely prepares you for the succulent and silky palate with its underlying stony freshness and crystalline purity at the breathtakingly focused and complex finish. Amazing stuff for what is de facto the village-wine category! From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold. Screw cap.



# RIESLING KIESELSANDSTEIN 2019

Obviously unfiltered and with low sulfites (or possibly no added sulfites), this is a veryimpressive natural wine with a level of elegance and subtlety that's rare in this category. Not quite fully dry, but this is where wild ferment sometimes leads. The positive tannins carry this extremely well, but alongside the autumnal yellow fruit aromas, there is a hint of funk. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold. Screw cap.



### SPÄTBURGUNDER GG – ÖDE HALDE 2018

A most unusual pinot noir with dried-sage and wet-earth notes that dominate the berry fruit. However, the balance of medium body, fine tannins and lively acidity on the palate is very satisfying. And with aeration the redcherry fruit expands. The long, fresh and complex finish suggests this still needs some time. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold.



#### LEMBERGER GG - SCHALKSBERG 2018

At first this is dominated by dried-sage and menthol aromas, but then the ripe-blackberry and spicy character powers through. Much less oak than most high-end lembergers and that suits this well-structured wine, which time has already polished well. Long, velvety finish with spicy complexity. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold.



### RIESLING JUNGES SCHWABEN 2020

Striking nose of candied citrus, flint and yeasty funk announce a daring dry riesling that functions like a natural wine, even though it's rather pale in color and clear in appearance for that category. Long, bonedry and fresh finish, in which mineral acidity and fine tannins are precisely matched. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold. Screw cap.



# RIESLING GIPSKEUPER 2019

This striking dry riesling has full mirabelle and super-ripe pear character with hints of fresh bread and wet earth, plus impressive textural complexity and a serious tannin structure. This is neatly bound together by the mineral acidity that gives it energy and brightness at the long, quite muscular finish. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink or hold. Screw cap.



#### **GRAUBURGUNDER 2019**

This may be made from the same grape variety, but it's light years removed from the average pinot grigio! Richly textured, but very dry, thanks to the base of fine tannins. Discreet caramelized-pear character with some dried-herb and spice notes. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink now. Screw cap.



#### **SAUVIGNON BLANC 2019**

Plenty of candied-citrus and some ripe-melon character on the nose, but also a whiff of funk from wild ferment and long sur-lie. However, it blows off quickly and then the richness comes out very nicely. The underlying tannin structure gives it good length. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Drink now. Screw cap.



# RIESLING GUTSWEIN – TROCKEN – 2019

For an entry-level, quality dry riesling from a region almost nobody associates with this grape, this is an impressive, medium-bodied wine that not only has a nice juiciness, but also some textural complexity, thanks to some positive tannins that neatly support the clean finish. From biodynamically grown grapes. Drink now. Screw cap.
